Discussion: Budget for 2023

<u>Motion #1</u> – Made by Becky St. Germaine, seconded by John Lamson; To use money available in HDC project line of 2022 Budget to pay someone to take meeting minutes. An amount of \$350 is available to be spent in 2022 for that purpose. Motion passes unanimously.

<u>Motion #2</u> – Made by Becky St. Germaine, seconded by John Lamson; Increase amount on Wages line of 2023 Budget to \$2,500, with increase on FICA/MEDI line to \$191.25 (7.65%) for the purpose of taking minutes in 2023. Motion passes unanimously.

<u>Motion #3</u> – Made by John Lamson, seconded by Becky St. Germaine; To accept a budget of \$9,491.25 for the year 2023. Also, \$3,000 of the \$10,000 CLG Grant, raised in March 2022 Town Meeting will be expended in 2022 as retainer fees for consultants working on a building assessment for the Old Stone School. The remaining \$7,000 will be encumbered to the 2023 budget to pay the final costs when the project is finished. Motion passes unanimously.

Further Discussion:

The amount of \$4,000 in the 2023 Budget under Special Projects, is based on previous costs of \$4000-\$7000 between 2003 to 2008 for the preservation of documents currently stored in town vault. This amount will cover the cost to digitize approximately 40% of original photos.

Recommendations for improvements of buildings in Historic District for use by townspeople listed and submitted with minutes. No motion needed.

<u>Motion #4</u> – Made by John Lamson, seconded by Becky St. Germaine; To approve the Historical Society Bonfire at the Old Stone School on December 17, 2022. The Tavern will be open at the Old Parsonage. Motion passes unanimously.
