Discussion:

Historical Documents – Estimates for digitizing photo albums, two potential vendors: Northeast Document Conservation Center (NEDCC), and Kofile Services. Both companies perform document digitization, restoration, preservation and storage of town documents. Kofile purchased the previously named Brown River Preservation Company, which was hired by the HDC in the early 2000's to preserve town documents.

Railroad Depot – Letter to Selectmen will be sent by HDC to the Board of Selectmen asking them to accept the property from the state on behalf of the town. If the BOS does not want to be responsible for the building, the HDC and Historical Society would like to lease the building from the town and to take responsibility for the building.

Motion to create a letter to the BOS made by Peggy Lamson, seconded by Becky St. Germaine. The motion passed unanimously.

Moose Grant – A motion was made by Becky St. Germaine, seconded by Peggy Lamson, to file an application with the NH Division of Historical Resources for a Moose Grant.
