What this office requires for permit issuance is a comparison between the 2015 IBC, 2015 NFPA 1, as amended by Saf-C6000 and the 2015 NFPA 101 Life safety code as amended by Saf-C 6000 and applicable referenced publications in Chapter 2.

Whichever code is the most restrictive Shall apply.

A Life Safety Permit is also required from the Newington Fire Department (NFD) and the Building Permit shall not be issued until this office receives an email from NFD that your permit from them has been issued.

All plans shall provide documentation that the Americans with Disability Act is being adhered for ingress, egress and all bathrooms shall be ADA accessible. Some FPEs will provide this as well as life safety
